



# WHAT TO GIVE OTHER THAN CASH



### **APPRECIATED STOCKS & SECURITIES**

- Avoid long-term capital gains tax by donating appreciated stocks or securities that you have owned over the years
- Receive a charitable income tax deduction based on the full fair market value of the security.
- Examples include gifts of stock, bonds, business interest, and even cryptocurrency.

### RETIREMENT ACCOUNT

- Include the Foundation as a beneficiary of your retirement account. We receive the full amount and pay zero income tax, getting the entire benefit of your gift.
- If you are 70 1/2 years or older, you can contribute up to \$100,000 from your IRA directly to the Foundation (except for donor advised funds) and avoid paying income taxes on the distribution.



### GRAIN



- Transfer and donate the grain to the Foundation's account at the grain elevator and the Foundation sells it with proceeds going into the fund of your choice.
- Avoid income tax on the donated grains.
- Deduct the production cost of the donated grain if possible.
